WHAT IS A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES PROVIDER?

Any industry consultant and/or professional services provider that can provide evidence of relevant qualification and a minimum of 3 years history of delivering quality outcomes in a chosen field of expertise to the community titles or strata living sector in Australia is eligible for registration with the ABMA as an Accredited Industry Practitioner – Professional Services Provider.

WHAT QUALIFICATIONS DOES A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES PROVIDER NEED?

In addition to mandatory tertiary qualifications and any practising or trade license required, eligible applicants will have at least one current industry association membership, annual subscription to the ABMA Building Management Code© and will be able to provide three (3) testimonials from past clients for specialty services provided to the sector across a minimum of three (3) years.

ABMA Accredited Industry Practitioners go onto the ABMA Register which is published for industry consumer reference.
